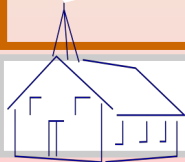
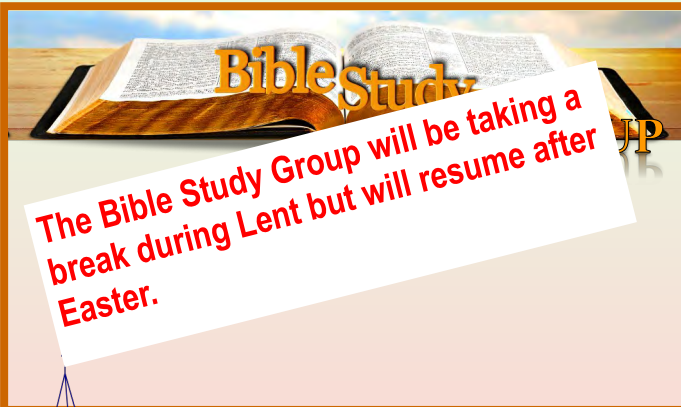
RCIA PROGRAMME FOR 2020

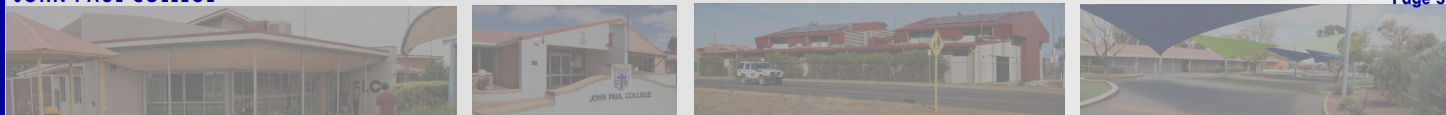

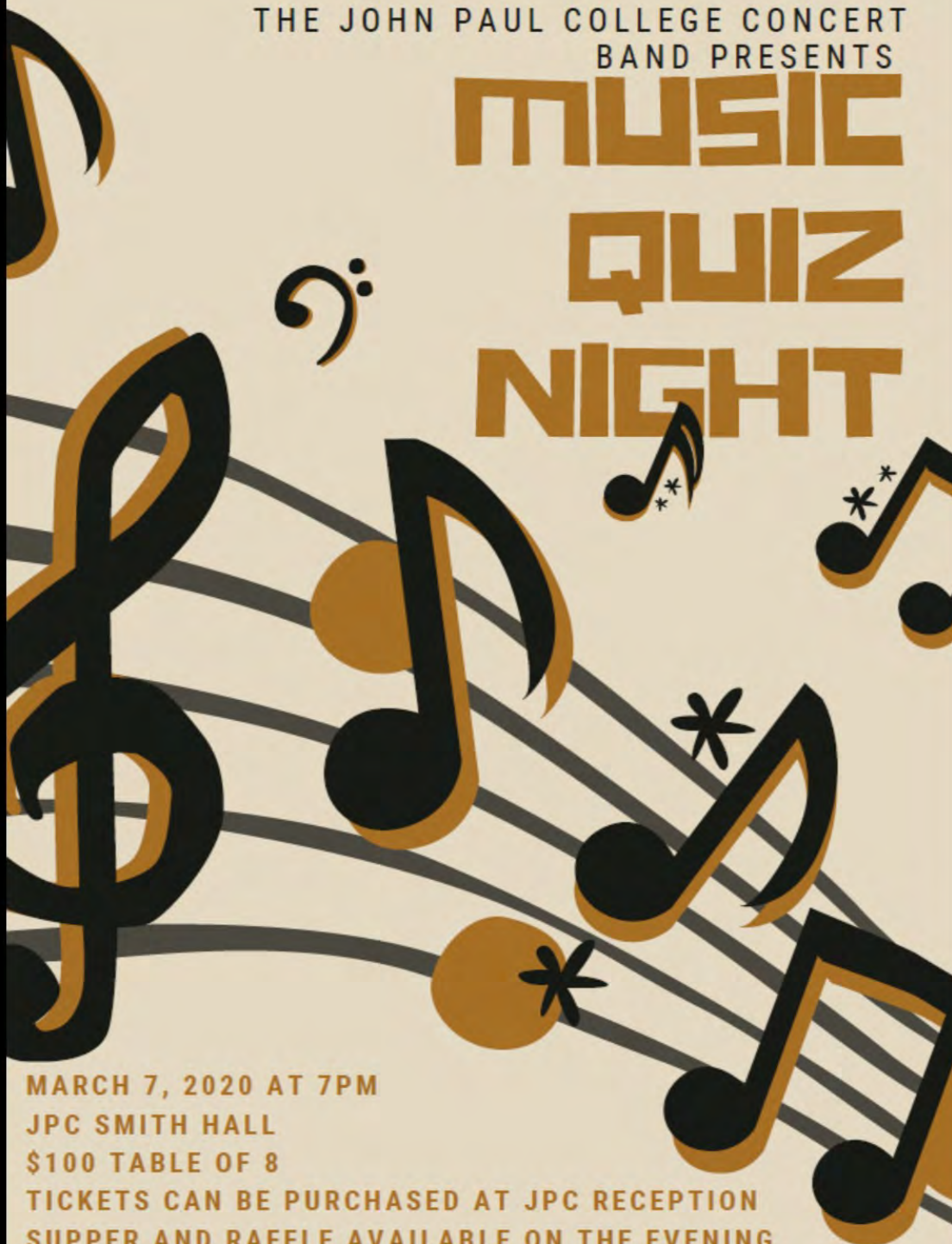
