Dear Parents, Families and members of the College Community,

As I mentioned last week, the Goldfields Esperance Merredin, Southern Cross (GEMS) Catholic Principals met at the College for 2 days this week. The workshop on the Power BI Data Analytics was enlightening and will provide us with a huge amount of data to assist with student improvement.

Part of the GEMS was also a presentation on the School Climate Surveys to be rolled out this year. This is the first of two surveys all College Community members will be asked to do. Data collected will inform us on our School Culture, Climate and Vision for Learning. More details will be forthcoming as the project evolves.

There has been much publicity about the Coronavirus Outbreak. Staff are emphasizing good hygiene habits to students and there have been changes to some Mass practices (no Communion from the Chalice and Sign of Peace handshake). 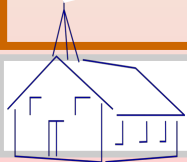
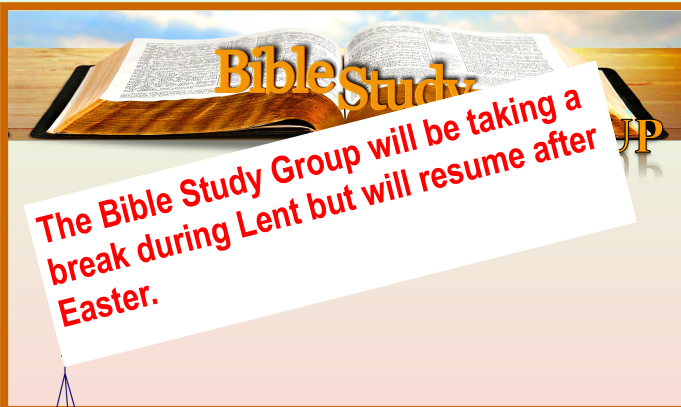
