



ENROLMENT AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

1. John Paul College is a co-educational Catholic school. Our aim is to promote the formation of the whole person in accordance with Gospel values. Christ is the model which the Catholic school offers to its students. Hence, students must agree to take part wholeheartedly in religious education lessons and to show genuine Christian commitment. This will involve treating other people with respect, accepting their differences and being prepared to help them if necessary. All students will be expected to take part in school Masses, retreats or other activities organised by the school.
2. As a student at John Paul College, you will be expected to try your best at each subject that you take. Homework is an important part of learning and you must account for the recommended homework time each week night and weekend. All set work is to be completed to the best of your ability. A serious attitude to study will help you get the most out of your school life.
3. As a student, fitness and enjoyment through sport and physical education are important to you. You will be required to take part to the best of your ability in the weekly P E classes and, also, in the annual swimming, cross-country and athletic carnivals and other sports days.
4. The school offers you the chance of further involvement in competitive sport and has interschool/regional teams in a wide variety of sports. You are expected to take part if selected.
5. The College, through its affiliated clubs, competes in district competitions in netball, basketball, hockey, soccer and football. You are expected to make yourself available for selection in these teams or discuss alternative arrangements at your enrolment interview.
6. Where overnight stays are essential for students, such as Outdoor Education camps, excursions, some Retreats and sporting events outside of Kalgoorlie-Boulder, a permission slip is required to be signed by parents.
7. Otherwise, where bus travel is a normal requirement of class or school activity and does not include overnight stay, permission slips will not be required.
8. A school needs to be orderly and disciplined so that the students present can co-operate with each other and the teachers. In this way, students are able to learn and grow. To this end the school has rules which the students must adhere to. These rules are reviewed regularly. A copy of the school rules is included in this Enrolment Package.
